



Occupational Health and Safety

Main Rules to Follow

ExpoCité places the utmost importance on everyone's health and safety. Beyond legal obligations, it is a core value that guides all our operations to ensure your events are both successful and memorable.

We rely on your proactive cooperation to comply with and enforce the main occupational health and safety (OHS) rules (clause 8.10 of your contract). As the primary tenant, you are also responsible for communicating these rules to your exhibitors, partners and collaborators, and ensuring their application.

Below are the main OHS rules to follow and enforce. Please note that this list is not exhaustive. You are required to comply with and always ensure compliance with all laws and regulations in force in Québec.

- Always **wear high-visibility apparel** (vest or bib) and safety shoes when circulating in the loading docks.
- **Ensure proper guidance** and **traffic control** during any vehicle reversing maneuvers.
- Shut off the engine of any vehicle parked inside the building immediately to limit the emission of harmful gases.
- **Avoid walking in front** of a moving forklift.
- **Do not allow children** under the age of 16 on site during setup and teardown.
- **Do not consume alcohol** during setup and teardown.
- **Use a ladder safely**, meaning:
 - Do not stand on the top step.
 - Do not lean the ladder sideways on any surface.
 - Do not sit on the top platform.
 - Do not straddle the ladder.
 - Do not turn your back to the ladder.
 - Do not climb on tables, chairs, columns or rolling boxes.
- **Wear a secured safety harness** for any work performed at heights above 3 metres.

No compromise or deviation regarding health and safety will be tolerated. Any non-compliant situation will be reported and must be corrected immediately to ensure a safe and healthy environment for all.
